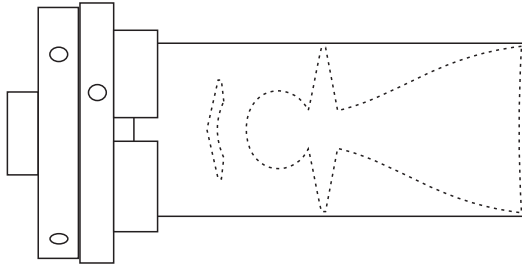
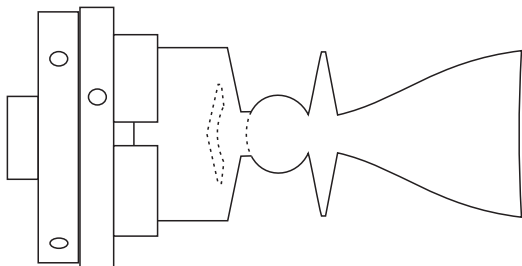


## Angel Christmas Tree Decoration

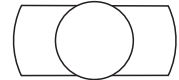
A simple little angel to hang on the tree. Decoration is the choice of the maker.



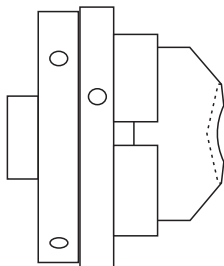
Mount a piece of wood that is about 90mm long and 45mm square in a chuck and round it off.



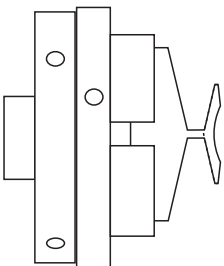
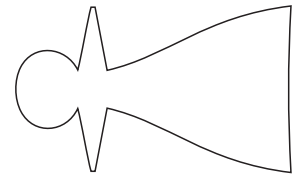
Cut the shape of the angel leaving only the top of the head uncut. You may cut the sides off the angels wings at this time or leave it until the angel is off the lathe. Sand and finish all this surface. Add any decoration you choose.

Finish the cut over the head of the angel. There is no need to sand this as the halo will cover this area. Cut the underside of the halo with enough curve to fit on the angel's head.



Shape the edges and then the top side of the halo. A straight skew chisel cut of the top surface of the halo should part it off and not require sanding.

Glue the halo to the Angel's head. Drill a little hole at the top central point and fit an eyelet or loop of thread to hang the angel on the Christmas tree.
