## SHALLOW BOX

The dimensions drawn here start with a block $100 \times 100 \times 45 \mathrm{~mm}$ plus more if you want the knob or finial to be part of the lid. They are for the box to include a glass butterfly as made for the Beads of Courage Programme. The space for the butterfly needs to be 65 mm dia and 20 mm high. The designs shown here all require a domed inside to the lid to ensure space for the butterfly.
The drawings on this page are full size. Print the page so that the measures at the lower left are correct.
The Clamshell Box project sheet details the process used to make this box.


If the edges of the lid extend beyond the edges of the bottom of the box so that the lid is easy to lift off, then no knob or finial is needed on the lid. A decoration may be made on the lid or inlaid into it.


If the lid is made to fit within the width of the box bottom then it needs a knob or finial to lift it by. Ensure that a knob is large enough to hold and a finial is robust enough to look like the correct place to lift the lid.

The bottom of the box needs a good flat interior and a broad, slightly concave, foot.
