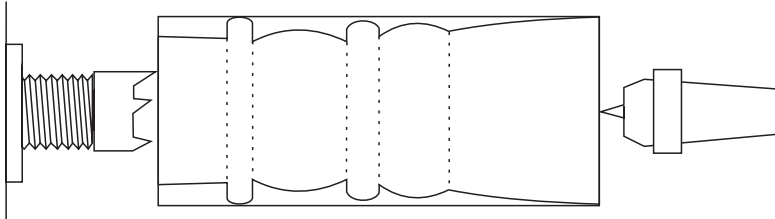


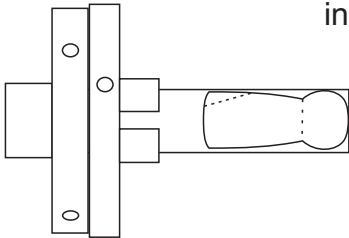
SNOWMAN

This snowman is a body with arms, nose, and scarf ends added. Then the whole item is painted. Start with a 70mm length of 30mm diameter dowel held between centres. Or a longer piece of 40mm square wood held in a chuck so that a 30mm diameter by 70mm long piece can be turned.

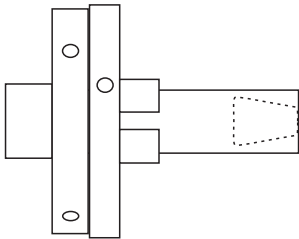


Shape the body of the snowman. Sand, but no finish.

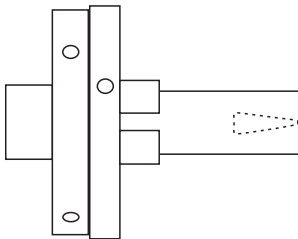
For the smaller parts take about 100mm of 10mm dowel and feed it into a small chuck so that only enough for each task is protruding.



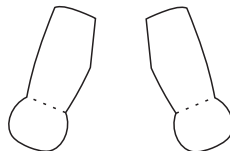
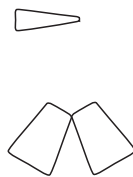
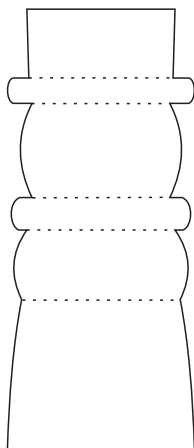
Make two arms. Each 23mm long. Sand a flat as indicated for attachment to the snowman body later.



Make a single turning 10mm long for the scarf ends. After parting off carefully split this lengthwise to make two flat-sided pieces.



Make a nose 10mm long.



Use hot melt glue to put all the parts together. Poke or drill a small hole in the top of the body. Put the ends of a loop of string into this hole and glue them in. Paint the snowman in the colours of your choice.
