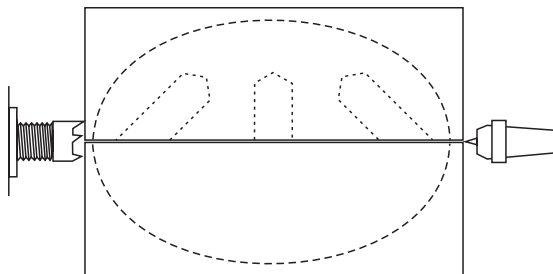
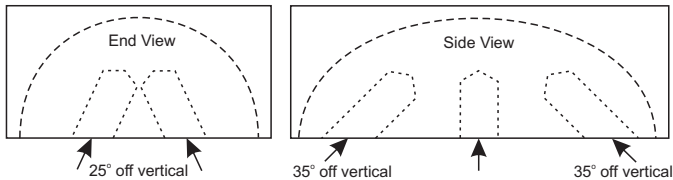
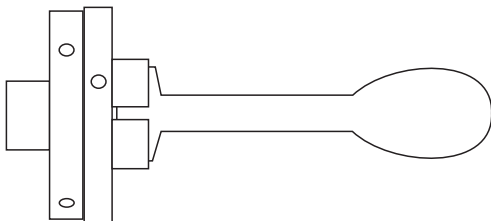


## SIX FOOT MASSAGER

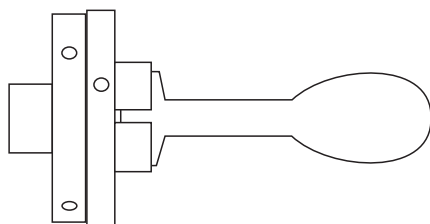
For the body use a piece 70mm wide and 35mm thick with a length of 100mm or more depending on whether you wish to turn this between centres or held in a chuck. Drill one side of this block as detailed below. Each hole is 10mm diameter and 15mm deep on the shortest side of the hole.



Use a paper joint to glue the body block to another block of the same size (or the body for a second Six Foot Massager). Mount this between centres and turn to shape. Sand and hand finish the ends. Separate the two blocks.



For the four long legs use pieces 25 x 25 x 100mm held in a scroll chuck. Turn these to the shape shown. The shaft of the leg needs to be 10mm diameter. Part or saw off to a total length of 80mm.



For the two shorter legs use pieces 25 x 25 x 85mm held in a scroll chuck. Turn these to the shape shown. The shaft of the leg needs to be 10mm diameter. Part or saw off to a total length of 65mm.

Assemble the massager with the longer legs in the outer holes. The shorter centre legs should not quite touch the table.  
Decorate the massager and apply a finish.
